Diapers (preferably large packs)	Diaper wipes
Lotion and/or diaper cream (if appropriate)	Pacifier (s) (No Wub-A-Nubs)
Bottles, including extra bottles (Silicone covers required for glass)	Feeding utensils and bowls (must be plastic or have silicone cover)
Breast milk or formula	2 cribs sheets (Graco/Target pack and play sheets fit best)
3 set of extra clothing, including socks	Sleep sacks ex: Zippity-Zip (All infants under 12 months, no swaddle or weighted sleep sacks)
Meal and snacks (if appropriate)	2 blankets (only if your child is over 12 months old)
Teething Rings (when needed)	Pre-filled out daily schedule
