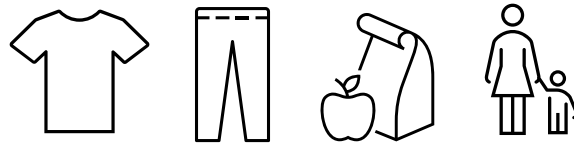

What to Bring for Your Toddler

Welcome to OFLC! Toddlerhood is an exciting time for your child. At Our Future Learning Center, we honor this important period by providing our toddlers with age-appropriate materials that help them develop socially, emotionally, physically, and academically. These materials include books, finger paints, musical instruments, and mats for children to rest on. However, we do ask families to supply some items for their toddlers. We do provide lunch during the day, but families are welcome to bring nut-free lunches from home! We ask that any items brought into Our Future Learning center are labeled with both the child's first and last name. Personal items will be returned home daily to be cleaned. Sheets and blankets will go home on Friday's or your child's last scheduled day each week. Please see below for a list of requested items. Thank you!



- 2 sets of emergency shirts (long or short sleeve) and bottoms (shorts or pants)
- 2 emergency sets of underwear and socks & 1 pair of extra shoes
- Labeled daily snacks or snacks for the week (classrooms have refrigerators)
- 2 clean sippy cups: 1 for water and 1 for milk and/or juice
- Materials for nap time including crib-sized sheet, blanket, and pillow.
- Diapers and wipes (if applicable)
- Sunscreen and hat (if enrolled during summer months)
- Water wear (if enrolled during summer months)
- A bag or backpack to bring back and forth from home to school (optional)
- A toothbrush and tube of toothpaste (optional)
